CDC Clinical Update

Announcement: Yellow Fever Vaccine Access

Updated April 18, 2017

Sanofi Pasteur, the manufacturer of the only yellow fever vaccine (YF-Vax) licensed in the United States, has announced that YF-Vax will be unavailable from mid-2017 to mid-2018 because of delays in the production process. Sanofi Pasteur applied and received approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to make another yellow fever vaccine available in the United States under an investigational new drug (IND) program. *Manufactured by Sanofi Pasteur in France, this vaccine, Stamaril, is registered and distributed in more than 70 countries. It is comparable in safety and efficacy to YF-Vax (see the [yellow fever vaccine information sheet](#)).

In order to meet the requirements of the IND program, Sanofi Pasteur can provide Stamaril to only a limited number of clinics. Sanofi has identified sites throughout the United States to include in the program so patients can have continued access to yellow fever vaccine.

Once YF-Vax is no longer available, travelers and health care providers will be able to find locations that can administer Stamaril by visiting the [yellow fever vaccination clinic search page](#). For information about which countries require yellow fever vaccination for entry and which countries the CDC recommends yellow fever vaccination, visit the CDC Travelers' Health website (www.cdc.gov/travel).

*Although the name of the FDA program is "investigational new drug," Stamaril is not investigational or experimental. Stamaril has been used in European and other countries for decades but is not licensed in the United States. IND is the mechanism through which FDA gives approval for Stamaril to be imported.

Schedule an appointment with us **as soon as you know** you'll be traveling internationally; some immunizations require more than one shot spread over a period of time, and others require time before travel to be most effective.

Travel Facts

- There is an **80% chance** you will have an illness when traveling in a less-developed country.
- There is an **80% chance** you will seek medical care while traveling internationally.
- After returning home, there is a **25% chance** you will experience diarrhea, respiratory illness, a skin problem, or a fever.

You can improve your individual degree of risk with proper education, immunizations, and prescriptions.

There is a national shortage of Yellow Fever vaccine

Utah County Health Department has worked through restricted supply of Yellow fever vaccine over the past several months. Currently, we have exhausted that supply. Please check back with us after May 7th for status of our Yellow fever supply at 801-851-7044.

- Come to Utah County Health Department (151 S University Ave Suite #1900 Provo) to receive your Yellow Fever vaccine and International Yellow Fever Card. Yellow Fever vaccine is not currently available in our American Fork clinic.
- Vaccines given prior to receiving Yellow Fever vaccine may result in a 30 day wait before getting the Yellow Fever vaccine. When you call you will be informed about vaccines that should not be given before your Yellow Fever vaccine.
- A fee of \$25 is charged for travel counseling without vaccine services.
- Please arrive prior to **3:00 pm** for travel immunizations with your **IMMUNIZATION RECORDS**. Plan to be with the immunization staff for up to 2 hours.
