It's THE Law

Front seat, back seat, it doesn't matter. All passengers must wear seat belts. Children up to age 8 must be properly restrained in a car seat or booster seat. If anyone under 19 isn't wearing one, the police can pull you over. If the vehicle is stopped for any violation, drivers and passengers over 16 can each receive their own seat belt citation.

Money

\$45 for a ticket is just the start. What would a trip to the emergency room or a head injury cost you?

Life & Death

Nobody plans on getting in a crash. Buckling up is the best thing you can do to reduce injuries and potentially save lives.

YOUR FAMILY

You don't want your family to be hurt. They likely feel the same about you. Show your care. Buckle up.

Not wearing a seat belt **endangers others**

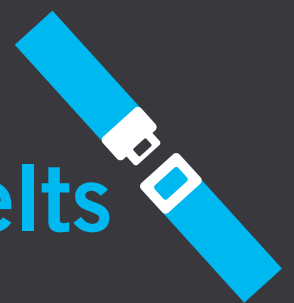
in the vehicle (if thrown in a crash).
